things you should know about the Third Sector in Salford ...

- 1** In 2010 there were **1,376** community and voluntary organisations, co-operatives and social enterprises in Salford.
- 2** In 2009-10 the total income of the sector was **£156 million**.
- 3** Medium and large organisations receive **93%** of the total sector income.
- 4** **963** organisations are micro (with an annual income under £10 thousand).
- 5** There are **20 thousand** volunteers in the sector.
- 6** Volunteers give **144 thousand hours** each week.
- 7** The contribution of volunteers in the sector is valued at **£121.7 million** each year.
- 8** The sector employs **6.5 thousand** full time equivalent paid staff.
