Have you faced racism or felt unsafe?

We know that seeking asylum can be difficult.

You are welcome here, and you have the right to feel safe in your community.

Racism is when someone treats you badly or unfairly because of your skin colour, where you are from, your culture, or nationality.

If someone is making you feel unsafe, it is important to report it. This helps protect everyone. You should report behaviour such as:

- Someone trying to enter your accommodation without permission.
- Someone filming you or coming close to you in a way that feels scary or uncomfortable.
- · Someone shouting at you, threatening you, or being violent.

Even if you are not sure it is a crime, you should report it to the police. Support is there to help you.
