Our courses 'Safe Care Closer to Home' will include training to deal with emergencies in collapsed adults and children, those with mental health issues, pregnant women and children being cared for at home with a tracheostomy.

Based on our well established approaches, training courses will be available to a wide variety of groups these will include structured training for those people who deliver training to others.

Courses are free of charge to people living in the Salford community and would be run with People Caring for Adults or Children, Young Carers and Personal Assistants (PA)
