All of our staff and volunteers can speak fluent Polish and English.

This project includes a friendly chat with Europaia and Europaia Art Collective staff and volunteers. We will then signpost as required to our Internal services like EUSS support, Legal Surgery, Welfare Advice, Hate Crime reporting, Europaia Emergency Fund, etc.* We can help provide access to local services like food banks, contact with housing associations, local councils and more.
